This is given to the new registered “Rookie” Leader who has done an outstanding job in their first year of service.

**Leaders of the Year: (Cubmaster, Scoutmaster, Crew Advisor, Skipper and Crew, Skipper, Pack and Troop Committee Member)**

This recognition is given to the experienced registered Scouting leader who has given exceptional service throughout the past year towards the success of their unit.

**Commissioner and Rookie Commissioner of the Year Award:**

This award recognizes a Commissioner and Rookies who has made a tremendous impact with the units he/she has been working with.

**District Committee Member of the Year:**

This award recognizes that District Committee member who warrants merit for service and dedication given over the past year.

**Bald Eagle Award :**

This award is presented to an individual registered in the Boy Scouts of America – Centennial District who has had no youth involved for the past 5 years. They need to have served in a variety of positions, and have countless hours of service with the Centennial District staff.

**Friends of Scouting Award:**

This award is presented to an individual or group not registered in the Boy Scouts of America – Centennial District who has had significantly supported Centennial District and its youth. They may have donated time, materials or other resources to enable our youth programs.

**Junior Leader Award:**

This award is given to a registered Scout(s) under the age of 21 who has shown an exceptional leadership ability above and beyond that of his/her peers.
